## Bigfoot & Camihoma Districts Merger Proposal:

All of these proposals must be approved by the District Executive Committee. You have a right to talk to your Zone representative to the District Executive Committee to express your opinion.

1. Name: Centennial District
2. Executive Committee: Follow the existing Bigfoot model. Second Counselor from each of the LDS Zones and representatives of the community unit Zones create one district executive committee for the new district.
3. District Chairman: Harold Nevill, Chair (existing Bigfoot Chairman)  
Dan Hauser, Assistant Chair (existing Camihoma Chairman)
4. District Commissioner: Either Ross Luekenga (existing Bigfoot Commissioner) or Bruce Lowder (existing Camihoma Commissioner) to become the combined District Commissioner. Decision to be made by the District Executive Committee
5. Monthly Round Table: Follow the existing Bigfoot model. Meet first Thursday in each month. Move location to a building that can accommodate the increased attendance: the current suggestion is Columbia High School
6. District Committees: Follow the national recommendation for district committee structure. Some committees would be created where none have existed before.  
  
District committees from both existing districts begin meeting in January to determine the “ideal” committee structure, functions, events, etc
7. District Spring 2010 Events: Klondike – remain split for both Districts (happening too soon)  
Training - combine but create a structure that can serve the entire district and the new requirement for 100% trained leaders by 2011  
May Awards banquet – combine (100<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration)  
Camporee – remain split for 2010  
Activities & Civic Service – create (new committee )  
Membership – combine  
Finance – combine (new committee structure)
